


Book Reviewers Rave about Go Green With Me

"Like the book *I'm Turning Green* that I reviewed in December, *Go Green With Me* follows a little girl as she takes simple steps to live more "green." With simple tips that even your youngest children can follow (turn off the water when you brush your teeth), to larger projects like composting (that you can do as a family), this book shows very real, practical steps we can all make to help save our environment. I think my kids' favorite part of the book were the pages on "worm composting" - because what child doesn't giggle when their mom reads to them using the word "poop?!" And they really could relate to the pages about farmers' markets and organic gardening since their dad has a garden in our back yard that they already help with. **So I give *Go Green With Me* 5 out of 5 binkies."**



"The first book, *Go Green With Me*, offers simple suggestions that kids can actually do. These are all illustrated with non-fussy simplistic drawings of EnviroGirl in action. Each page gives a simple action ("When washing and brushing, be a drip spotter! Let's help the Earth- turn off that water!"). But also gives a fact reinforcing the concept ("You can save up to five gallons of water by turning off the faucet each time you brush your teeth and wash your hands."). For me, when I read this book to my four-year-old the first time, I only read the large text with the suggestion and didn't overwhelm her with facts. With an older kid, or during subsequent readings, you could certainly read all the text on each page. Additionally, there are "Earth Notes" at the end of the book with steps that the entire family can take to conserve energy and resources. And let me tell you, kids love hearing about worm poop! (Compost.)"
